THE DEVILS ALSO BELIEVE, AND TREMBLE

LL CREATION IS commanded to tremble and bow before Almighty God. Mankind and the very angels and demons know their place!

1 The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: He sitteth between the cherubims; let the earth be moved.

Psalms 99:1 The BIBLE

All will bow before Him:

29 All they that be fat upon earth shall eat and worship: all they that go down to the dust shall bow before Him: and none can keep alive his own soul.

Psalms 22:29 The BIBLE

So the mere fact that we tremble at the Name of God doesn't justify us before God; indeed, the very demons tremble at the mention of His Name!

19 Thou believest that There Is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

James 2:19 The BIBLE

In other words, God tells us that there are two kinds of people who tremble and bow before Him: those who do His will, and those who do not: those in whom He delights, and those in whom He does not:

2 For all those things hath Mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at My Word.

...

4 I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine

eyes, and chose that in which I delighted not.

5 Hear the Word of the LORD, ye that tremble at His Word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for My Name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but He shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.

Isaiah 66:2, 4-5 The BIBLE

Jesus repeated this message:

18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. 20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

21 Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father Which Is in heaven.

22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy Name? and in Thy Name have cast out devils? and in Thy Name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, ye that work iniquity.
